WHAT IS SNAP?

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) offers nutrition assistance to millions of eligible, low-income individuals, including children, senior citizens, and families. Formerly known as the food stamp program, SNAP also provides economic benefits to communities.

SNAP helps households improve food security, reducing the number of people who skip meals because they do not have the money or resources to buy enough food.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR SNAP?

SNAP benefits are determined by your monthly income and the number of family members per household. To learn more about eligibility and how to apply for benefits, visit your local N.C. agency office or online at EPASS.NC.GOV.

WHAT IS DOUBLE BUCKS?

Double Bucks helps you bring home affordable, healthy food by matching your SNAP dollars spent at participating farmers markets.

SNAP users get tokens in place of cash for purchases at farmers markets. SNAP users do not need to enroll for Double Bucks – just bring your EBT card to participating markets.

USE DOUBLE BUCKS AT THE MARKET!

- 01 **Go** to your farmers market information tent.
- 02 **Swipe** your EBT card for tokens to use as cash.
- 03 **Double** your EBT dollars up to \$50.
- 04 **Shop** for fresh produce, including fruit, vegetables, plant starters, bread, eggs and more!



TRANSPORTATION

Individuals 60 and older and individuals with disabilities may qualify for low-cost transportation (\$1.50 per person each way) to and from the farmers markets. Call 704-336-4547 for more information.
